The not-for-profit association « Espace René Carcan » as organiser of the René Carcan International Prize for Printmaking, has successfully launched its 4th call for entries.

Established in 2014 to mark the 20th anniversary of the death of the Belgian watercolour artist and printmaker René Carcan (1925-1993), the Prize fulfils the artist's wish to promote engraving and prints.

#### SEVERAL PRIZES WILL BE AWARDED

- the **International Grand Prix**, with prize money of €5,000 is awarded to the best artist chosen by an international jury;
- a **First runner-up**, with prize money of €3,000 is awarded to the second best artist chosen by an international jury;
- a **Second runner-up**, with prize money of €2,000 is awarded to the third best artist chosen by an international jury;
- the **Public Prize**, voted on by Internet users an honorary prize.

Intended for etchers and apprentice etchers from all countries and without age restrictions using the following techniques: embossing, lithography, linocut, xylo engraving, screen printing and monotype.

Entries must be registered by **30 September 2021** at the latest on the website [www.renecarcan.org](http://www.renecarcan.org).

The prize-giving ceremony and the opening of the exhibition will take place on **Saturday 5 February 2022** in the Bibliotheca Wittockiana, the exhibition will be held until **1 March 2022**.

For this project, the Espace René Carcan has joined forces with the King Baudouin Foundation, creating under its auspices the **René Carcan Foundation** to promote the art of printmaking and, more particularly, the works of René Carcan.
